DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST is executed in the town of SASARAM on 27th day of November in the year One thousand nine hundred and ninety eight by Khaja Syed Shah Md. Momin (Chief Priest of Khanqah Nezamia) late Hazrat Mir Nezam Ali resident of Mohalla Kabir Gau, Sasaram, P.S. Sasaram, Distt. Rohtas (hereinafter called the Founder) in favour of "MOMIN EDUCATIONAL & WELFARE TRUST", (hereinafter called the Trust) through its secretary Syed Ilyas Ahmed, late Fakhruddin Ahmed resident of Mohalla Karan Sarai Sasaram, P.S. Sasaram, Distt. Rohtas entrusting the subject matter of the Trust in the Board of Trustees, constituted earlier and confirmed by this deed (hereinafter called the Board), as set forth herein below.

Whereas the founder has established a charitable trust in his own name for the development of Educational and welfare programme among the Muslims in particular and the people of India in general and for this purpose he has already contributed a sum of Rs.5,000.00/- (Rupees five thousand only).

Whereas a Board of Trustees consisting of the following eleven persons was constituted on 2nd January, 1995.

And, whereas the said trustees have consented to act as the first trustees of these presents with all the rights and duties in respect of the subject matter of the trust for carrying out the objects of the trust and in the manner hereinafter provided:-

Now this trust deed witnesseth as follows.

NAME OF THE TRUST:

- a) The name of the Trust shall be "AL-MOMIN EDUCATIONAL & WELFARE TRUST" CENTRAL
- b) That the principal office of the trust shall be in the campus of ~~Ideat~~ English School in Khanquah Nezamia, Kabir Ganj, Sasaram but the trustees shall have the power to shift the office of the trust to any other place or open sub-office in such places as are deemed fit.

(2). AIMS & OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

That the objects for which this trust is established are :

- a). To work for the educational, social, cultural and economic advancement of Muslim minority community in particular and the people of India in general.
- b). To impart moral and spiritual values in keeping with the Islamic ideals in the field of education.
- c). To establish and administer educational institutions and to provide facilities of education to all without any consideration of caste and creed.
- d). To impart vocational & technical training for the eradication of unemployment and to organise professional courses as per requirement of the time.
- e). To establish free coaching centre for the students of Muslim minority community and to ensure their employment and admission to institute.
- f). To make all round development of women, making them self-reliant by providing them technical & vocational training.
- g). To provide health care to those in need and to make all round efforts for the prevention of drug abuse, and alcoholism and to work for the prevention of AIDS.
- h). To work for the liberation, educational training and rehabilitation of children engaged in child labour and other unorganised occupations such as shoe polishing rag picking etc.

- i). To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, widows and aged persons.
 - j). To work for the promotion of Urdu language, literature and research works.
 - k). To establish a fund for the purpose of granting scholarships to deserving students for continuation of their studies.
 - l). To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retired persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
 - m). To do everything for the welfare of minorities and other backward classes in particular and the people of India in general.

(3). OFFICE BEARERS OF THE TRUST :

That the office bearers of the trust shall be as follows.

- a). President
- b). Vice-president
- c). Secretary
- d). Treasurer

The board of trustees shall elect the office bearers from amongst themselves by a majority of the trustees and they shall remain in office for 5 years. The board will elect office bearers for the next term within a month of expiry of the term.

(4). BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

The board of trustees shall consist of eleven members including the president, vice president, secretary and treasurer. The management and control of the trust and trust properties shall vest in the board of trustees. The persons above named shall be the trustees constituting the first board of trustees in whom the control of trust shall vest.

The trustees may co-opt. or appoint new trustees as patrons, life members etc. from amongst those donors of the trust who accept aims and objects of the trust and agree to abide by rules and regulations of trust.

(5). BOARD MEETING :

- a). A meeting of the board shall be held ordinarily once in 3 months or earlier on the requisition of at least 1/3 of the trustees to consider the affairs of the trust. All general meetings shall be convened by the secretary and all the proceedings of the meeting shall be recorded in minutes book to be preserved

d). **TREASURER**

The treasurer shall be responsible for the issue of receipts and vouchers for funds received or paid out by the trust. He will keep the members informed regarding financial condition of the trust during board meetings. He will maintain accounts of the trust, get the same audited and help the secretary in preparing the proposed budget for the next year.

(7). OPENING AND OPERATING BANK ACCOUNT :

The trustees may open any account or accounts in the name of the trust in any schedule Bank or Banks as per decision of the board of trustees. The bank accounts shall be jointly operated by the secretary and either treasurer or any member authorised by the Board.

(8). VACANCIES :

A vacancy shall arise among the trustees in the following cases ;

- a). When the trustee dies;
- b). When he resigns his office as a trustee;
- c). When he is absent from the consecutive meetings of the board, unless the board records condoning such absence on the minutes of the meetings of the board of trustees for substantial cause;
- d). When he becomes insolvent;
- e). When he is convicted of any criminal offence involving moral turpitude;
- f). When he acts or does anything detrimental to the interest of the trust.
- g). On medical evidence, when he is found physically or mentally unfit by a resolution of the board of trustees passed for the purpose.

In case of any vacancy arising among the trustee new trustees shall be nominated and appointed and they shall be of sound mind, who are not employees of the trust, and shall be above eighteen years of age and shall subscribe to the objects of the trust.

(9). POWER OF TRUSTEES

That for the furtherance of the object of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers;

- a) To call for and collect and receive funds and such funds may be utilised by them for such purposes and objects of the trust as they deem fit.

- b). To accept and receive donations, contributions, grants or subscription.
- c). To acquire movable and immovable property by purchase or otherwise.
- d). To erect or cause to be erected building or buildings, equipments and machinery of the use, benefit and attainment of the objects of the trusts.
- e). To sell, transfer, exchange, convey and alienate or mortgage movable and immovable properties belonging to the trust whenever acquired in future.
- f). To manage, administer and control properties and all assets of the trust directly or indirectly and all institutions under or connected with the trust.
- g). To demand call for and realise moneys and other assets due or belonging to the trust and issue receipts and vouchers for the receipts of the same.
- h). To employ necessary staff for the management, administration and running of the trust in general and for the institutions under the trust in particular and for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust of such terms as may appear proper to the trustees and to delegate and to allot to such staff from time to time such powers and duties as may be necessary in the usual course of business.
- i). To appoint from time to time and at any time to suspend, dismiss, remove or discharge any person under their control including clerks, accountant and to re-employ them with such power and duties and upon such terms either by giving one month notice or by giving one month's salary as the board of trustees shall think proper.
- j). To apply to Government, public bodies, philanthropic organisations or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid and other assistance with views to promoting the objects of the trust.
- k). The board shall have full powers to make amend, delete or rescind rules and by laws of the trust.
- l). To do all acts and things which are connected with the administration of the trust in general and of the institutions in particular and which are deemed by the trustees to be in the best interest of the trust and are desirable.

(10). WINDING UP OF THE TRUST :

The trustees shall have powers to wind up the trust activities. In this case, the remaining assets for trust shall be handed over to the managing committee of Patna Muslim High School for achieving similar aims and objectives. Such decision may be taken by the votes of at least 4/5 of the trustees present in a specially called board meeting attend by at least 3/4 of the existing trustees.

(11). GENERAL.

the trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or their duties relating thereto.

(12). The accounting year of the trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.

(13). It is expressly declared that this is a public charitable trust. No part of the trust fund, either corpus or the income therefrom shall be utilised for any purpose other than that of the trust hereby created or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law.
